



In Memorium - Shirley Ericson
September 29, 1930 - January 4, 2018

Shirley Ericson was born in Harris, Missouri, on September 29, 1930. She attended Arizona State University where she received her Bachelors Degree in Music Education. She went on to receive her Doctorate of Education at Washington State University.

In 1950 she married Robert Ericson in Scottsdale, Arizona; they were married for 67 years. Shirley worked for the Richland School District for 16 years, and then for the University of Central Florida for 11 years.

She was an active member of the Jardineros de Placitas and Libro sin Nombre Book Club. She served on the Board of Directors of the Placitas Artists Series and served as the chair of the publicity committee. She also served as Publicity Chair for the Placitas Community Library and Garden Tour. She was a member of the Brevard Symphony Orchestra Board.

Shirley was a long-time Placitas resident and supporter of the Placitas Artists Series. She and Bob sponsored concerts for a number of years, and she and her daughter Leslie, also a Placitas resident, were always in the audience at our concerts.
